

# Welcome to 4th Grade!

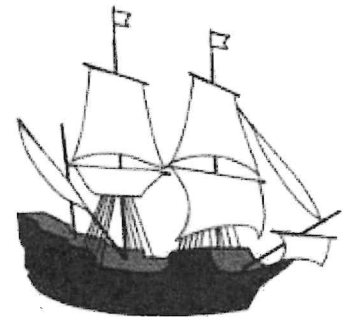


Dear Third Grade Student,
